To All Applicants: Prevention First Colorado invites you to apply to our 1st ever CYRJ program. Based on our belief that youth can be powerful advocates for social change, CYRJ seeks to train and empower young people (grades 11 and 12) as effective advocates. CYRJ will pull students from all over JeffCo, with a goal of 10-15 active students in its pilot semester (spring 2012).

Time Commitment: Bi-monthly meetings take place in the 1st and 3rd weeks of each month in the early evening (location and day TBD). Additional small group meetings and one-on-ones with older organizers/mentors will take place throughout the year.

Students will be expected to provide their own transportation, though some public transportation stipends are available.

CYRJers should expect to spend up to 10 hours per month outside of meetings working on advocacy projects.
